JOB: Custodian – Fruitdale High School

The Washington County Board of Education will accept applications for the position of Custodian at Fruitdale High School. Duties will be but are not limited to general maintenance on campus (replacing light bulbs, replacing window panes, AC filters, and other general repairs) sweeping classrooms, grass mowing and operating a weed eater. The minimum salary will be \$16,698 based on a 202 (8 hour) day contract. A complete salary schedule can be obtained by visiting the Central Office in Chatom, AL. Applications will be in person only and should be submitted to the Superintendent's Office at the Washington County Board of Education, Chatom, Alabama.
