The person hired must hold a valid Alabama Teachers' Certificate with an endorsement in Family and Consumer Science or Home Economics. The minimum salary will be \$41,690 based on the salary matrix and a 187-day contract. A complete salary schedule can be obtained by visiting the Central Office in Chatom, Alabama. Applications will be received by mail or in person only and should be submitted to the Superintendent's Office at the Washington County Board of Education in Chatom, Alabama.
