The Washington County Board of Education will be accepting applications for the position of Mathematics Teacher with a possible TEAMS contract at Washington County High School. The person hired must hold a valid Alabama Teachers' Certificate with an endorsement in Mathematics. The minimum salary will be \$41,690, based on the salary matrix and 187 days in the contract. A complete salary schedule can be obtained by visiting the Central Office in Chatom, Alabama. Applications will be received in person, by mail, or online and should be submitted to the Superintendent's Office at the Washington County Board of Education, Chatom, Alabama.

The deadline for submitting applications will be Wednesday, July 6, 2022, at 11:00 A.M.

All applicants selected for positions must have undergone an ABI/FBI criminal history background check (fingerprinting administered through sites selected and approved by the WCBOE and State of Alabama Education Department).
