The Washington County Board of Education will accept applications for the position of Custodian at Millry High School.

Duties will be, but are not limited to:

- General maintenance on campus (replacing light bulbs, replacing window panes, AC filters, and other general repairs)
- Sweeping classrooms,
- Grass mowing
- Operating a weed eater
- Other duties assigned by the administrator

The minimum salary will be \$24,724 based on a 202 (8-hour) days contract. A complete salary schedule can be obtained by visiting the Central Office in Chatom, AL. Applications will be accepted in person, through the mail, or by email and should be submitted to the Superintendent’s Office at the Washington County Board of Education, Chatom, Alabama. If an applicant applies through email, he or she will receive a confirmation email from the WCBE office. **If you do not receive a confirmation email, then the application was not received.**

Applicants must complete all sections of the Classified Application plus the Custodian Worker Insert.

The forms can be found on the WCBOE web-site at wcbek12.org under Human Resources. Applications must be brought to the Superintendent’s Office at the Washington County Board of Education in Chatom, AL. Applications will be accepted in person, through the mail, or by email.

Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Please have applications completed when you arrive at the office to submit it.

Late applications will not be accepted.
